2014

Leola attends the One World Everybody Eats Summit in Denver and begins conversations with FM area locals about a community café.

2016

Leola joins the One World Everybody Eats Summit in Austin and the Folkways Co-Starters program. She also connects with NDSU Dietetic students and Tracy Walvatne of Josie's Corner Café.

2017

Cafés continue at Josie's Corner Café on Sundays, including 13 events and appearances at the Red River Market.

2019

Thirty cafés are hosted. A partnership with First Presbyterian Church begins, providing kitchen and storage space.

2021

Sack lunches continue. Heart-n-Soul and First Presbyterian deliver 300 Thanksgiving meals; Olivet Lutheran helps with 300 Christmas meals. An anonymous donation funds a food trailer—The Mobile Café—which starts operating in July.

2023

A total of 7,703 lunches and holiday meals are served, including for Thanksgiving and Christmas.

HEART-N-SOUL TIMELINE

2015

She continues promoting the idea and begins forming a nonprofit, filing Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State.

2016 (continued)

Heart-n-Soul launches its first "Pay What You Can" café at Josie's Corner Café with NDSU Dietitians and volunteers. Over a dozen cafés follow, forming ties with local farmers.

2018

Heart-n-Soul expands to 24 cafés across multiple locations, including farmers markets and kitchen spaces. They also sponsor the film A Place at the Table at the Fargo Theater.

2020

Eight events are held before the pandemic hits. Volunteers shift to making 300–500 weekend lunches at Square One Kitchens, supported by a fundraiser and bun donations from Breadsmith.

2022

The Mobile Café serves 3,658 guests, with 2,004 paying what they can. Friday lunches persist.

2024

The Mobile Cafe and lunch program continued to expand. We saw a 22% increase of guests who paid what they could.
